This document contains the specifications for display advertising, classified advertising, and inserts/outserts for *Nature*, Nature-branded journals and Academic journals, which are printed across the world in a variety of formats and by several print houses. As such, the advertising available for individual titles varies along with the advert dimensions and who to contact or send samples to. Please follow the instructions (right) to find the details you need.

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USING THIS GUIDE

- In the appropriate section, first find the journal of interest in the Table, then read across to discover the journal's page size, what is available for that title, and the Production contact.
- If you need to contact Production, the details are listed on page 3.
- The precise dimensions and other specifications for the various adverts are presented after the tables.
- Finally, take note of the technical specifications and other details on page 3.

Although we make every effort to ensure that the specifications in this document are accurate, they can be subject to change. Therefore, please check the specifications with us before sending any material for design or print.

General information

Technical specifications

Artwork should be supplied in PDF format. To ensure good reproduction of your artwork please supply a PDF to PDF/X-1a standard. If this is not possible, supply a standard CMYK, high resolution PDF (at least 300dpi), with all fonts and images embedded. Ensure that bleed is included and clearly shown with bleed marks.

- PDFs should not use any passwords or security options
- Artwork should be pre-flattened so there are no transparent objects in the supplied file
- Full page advertisements must have a bleed of 3.175 mm (0.125")
- Should not exceed ink density of 300%

Colour

- All files must use a CMYK or greyscale colour space
- No spot colours should be used
- No colour management, ICC profiles or Lab colour should be used

Images

- Images should be no less than 300dpi
- Images must be CMYK or greyscale

Proofs

For best colour reproduction you must supply an accurate colour proof. Send via conventional mail to your production contact. The proof must have been created from the same digital files as those supplied to us. For monochrome advertisements, a laser print is sufficient.

Insert samples

A sample of the insert needs to be approved by the Production department prior to insertion with the journal. Ideally this should be the actual piece, but if not available, a mock-up trimmed to the exact dimensions, using the same paper and folded or perforated as the final insert would be, should be provided. This needs to be with us at least two weeks prior to the issue date. A digital copy can also be sent in advance to check for content.

Please send 5 samples to the Production contact for the journal (see Table), clearly identifying the front and back of the insert, or the page numbers where appropriate.

See below for insert specifications and also page 3 for other technical specifications. Once approved, inserts will need to be delivered to the relevant printing house; follow the delivery instructions from your Production contact.

Insert/outsert specifications

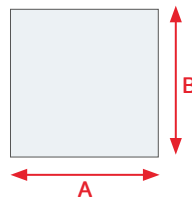
All journals are printed in a portrait format at a trimmed page size of 210 mm × 279 mm (8.25" × 11"). Please check the Table to ensure that the type of insert/outsert you require is available or contact Production. Listed on the following pages are the permitted dimensions and paper weights for the specific insert types.

It may be possible to accommodate types of inserts other than those shown in the Table above; please contact your sales representative to discuss any special requirements.

Tip-on

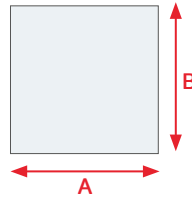
- Supply to the trimmed size.
- Must be square or portrait.
- Front cover tip-ons will be positioned in the bottom left-hand corner.
- A tip-on can have a specified position on the page; however, there is a movement tolerance of up to 10 mm (0.4")

Loose insert

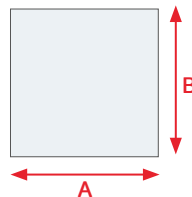
- Must be supplied to the trimmed size.
- It is not possible to insert a concertina (z-fold) folded insert.
- Inserts must have a closed spine.
- All loose inserts of four pages or more are fed into the publication spine first.
- Should be no more than 8 pages.
- Maximum overall weight for the insert is 90 grams (3 oz). For heavier items please contact your sales representative as this will incur extra distribution costs.
- Postal regulations in the USA greatly increase the cost of running loose inserts.

Loose outsert

- Must be supplied to the trimmed size.
- It is not possible to insert a concertina (z-fold) folded insert.
- Outserts must have a closed spine.
- Must be no more than 32 pages.
- Maximum overall weight for the outsert is 90 grams (3 oz). For heavier items please contact your sales representative as this will incur extra distribution costs. We recommend for a single sheet, 90–150 gsm; for 4–6 pages, 70–130 gsm; and for 8–32 pages, 48–80 gsm.

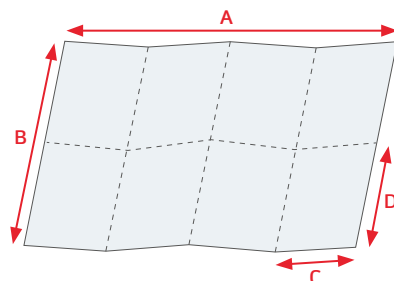

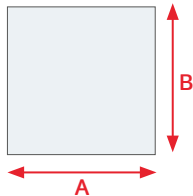

- Must be supplied folded with a closed edge.
- Recommended paper weight is 130 gsm (90 lbs)

Two/four-page bound insert

- Must be supplied at the untrimmed size.
- All text should be at least 10 mm (0.4") from the edge of the final trim size.
- The height of the insert must exceed the width.
- Four-page inserts must be pre-folded on the spine edge. Include a 3 mm (0.125") spine trim on each page in the centrefold (6 mm total) — it will be trimmed on binding.

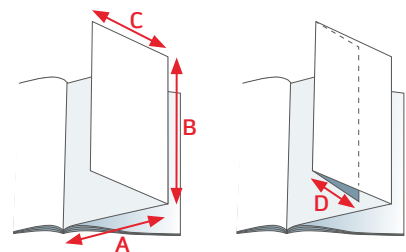

Four-panel rollfold

- Must be supplied pre-folded to the untrimmed size.
- It is not possible to insert a concertina (z-fold) folded insert.
- The insert should be folded so that it opens out toward the right-hand side.
- Panels can be added by reducing the width by 5 mm for each additional panel.
- All text should be at least 10 mm (0.4") from the edge of the final trim size.

Belly band

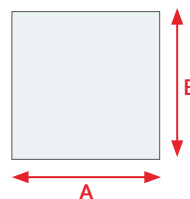
- Belly bands are usually only possible on special distributions, such as conference copies. Contact your sales representative for details.
- Must be supplied pre-scored but unfolded
- The back panels will overlap (60 mm, 2.5"). Ensure that no text or important information is in this area.
- Contact us for spine width, which will depend on the journal's spine width,

Blow-in card

- Must be supplied to the trimmed size.
- For *Nature*, the insert will be blown-in in the 'American edition' and loose inserted/outserted in the 'European edition' and 'Asia-Pacific edition'.
